Festivities will open with a New Year's Eve dance on Friday December 31st at 8pm Then the Chili Cook-Off will start at 10am followed by the Polar Bear Plunge at 3:30pm! This part of the event will begin on stage at the pavilion at promptly 3:30pm for a money raising auction called Calcutta Pool! Last year's event was a huge success! - All the money raised through the "auction" goes into a "pool!"

RULES

Participants will not be allowed to plunge if you are inebriated, intoxicated, too merry, too happy, too high, tight, in other words... DRUNK!! Alcohol will make your blood pressure low and plunging will make it lower! Please be mindful of your abilities!

Important Details:

▪ The event will take place at the cement slab common area along the Frio River located behind the Frio Pecan Farm Pavilion. Participants will parade down TOGETHER from the pavilion after Calcutta Pool Auction (details below).

The Frio River Polar Bear Plunge is not suitable for anyone without a sense of humor. However, please do not "let it all hang out!" This is a family event! Let's keep this fun, ya'll!

- Every FRPBP participant is required to sign a release. These will be available online when you register and when you check-in. You will not be allowed to take part in the event without a signed Release.
- Participants are expected to immerse their entire body! That means your pretty little head too! DO NOT DIVE!
- We all strive to create a fun experience for all those involved. Please be respectful of those around you, the grounds and all facilities on the property. Polar Bear Plunge friends, please take care of your plungers! Safety is our number one priority.
- Participants can change in pavilion restrooms but it's gonna be cold there too!!! HeHeHe!!!
- Winners will be announced that evening at 6:30pm in Frio Pecan Farm pavilion!
- PICK UP YO TRASH! Your mamma raised you better!!!

What is a Calcutta Pool Auction?

In simplest terms, Calcutta Pool works like this:

- Bidders make a wage, auction style, on the participant they think will win the event. Participants will be judged on costume, stage presentation and entrance into the Frio River!
- If your bid is the highest, you bought the participant.
- All the money raised through the "auction" goes into a "pool."
- At the end of the event, the winning bidder & Polar Bear participant will receive a **predetermined** percentage from the auction "pool." Remaining funds to benefit stated charity!

NO PARTICIPANT WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO PLUNGE WITHOUT SIGNING THIS RELEASE!

In exchange for being permitted to participate in the FRPBP aka "FRIO RIVER POLAR BEAR PLUNGE" (Event), I agree and acknowledge as follows: All parties known as "Releasees" are as follows: **Frio Pecan Farm, Suttle & Associates, Leahey VFD, Frio Canyon EMS, their employees, staff, volunteers, agents and all other representatives** as such.

1. FRIO PECAN FARM & SUTTLE & ASSOCIATES, its employees, staff, volunteers, etc. is conducting an event called FRIO RIVER POLAR BEAR PLUNGE as noted above. I will run, walk, parade, jump, swim, and take any other actions to complete FRPBP in existing weather, good or bad. In consideration of participating in the Frio River Polar Bear Plunge, I represent that I understand the nature of the event. I represent that I am, participating and qualified to participate, in good health, and in proper physical condition to participate in the event. I acknowledge that I have been advised by FRPBP to consult a physician prior to participation.
2. If I participate, I will do so only in designated areas, in a lawful and safe manner and with property equipment, and I will obey all signs, notices, and directives. I will not use, possess or loan to other as any dangerous devices (including weapons, firearms, or fireworks).
3. I acknowledge that if I believe the event conditions are unsafe for me, I will immediately discontinue participation in the event. I fully understand the event involves risks of serious bodily injury, including permanent disability and death, which may be caused by: my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others; the conditions in which the event takes place; and/or the negligence of the Releasees named below. If I am injured, I will not make any claim against "Releasees". I will also indemnify (reimburse) FRIO PECAN FARM & SUTTLE & ASSOCIATES if any person makes a claim against if for anything I did.
4. I hereby understand and acknowledge that all fees and associated costs (including optional product purchases and donations), paid in registration for this Event are NOT REFUNDABLE FOR ANY REASON, under any circumstances, including but not limited to injury, a scheduling conflict, Acts of God (including fire, flood, earthquake, storm, hurricane or other natural disaster) and /or event cancellation.
5. As a participant, I understand I will be placed in a designated area on the event by FRPBP. While in my designated area, I will follow all directions given to me by FRPBP as well as stay within the boundaries dictated by my assigned area on the event. 7. I will at all times conduct myself in a careful manner, will not injure or damage any other person or property and will obey all laws, event rules and event staff (including security personnel engaged by FRPBP).
8. I fully accept and assume all risks and all responsibility for losses, costs and damages that I incur in connection with my participation in the event. I hereby release from all liability, discharge and covenant not to sue: the "Releasees" its administrators, directors, agents, volunteers, and employees; other participants; sponsors; advertisers; and the owners and lessors of the premises on which the event takes place (all and each of the foregoing are "Releasees"). I understand that I am releasing all claims, demands, losses or damages of any kind, sustained by me, whether caused in whole or part by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise, including negligent rescue operations. I further agree that if, despite this release, waiver of liability and assumption of risk, anyone making a claim against the Releasees I will indemnify, save and hold harmless each of the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage or cost which may result from such claim.

Plunging Apparel

The morning of the polar plunge when you're trying to decide what to wear, keep in mind that you'll want something that is easy and quick to get out of. The Frio River Polar Bear Plunge Crew recommends going with the old standby bathing suit. However, you can also opt for a pair of shorts, with a drawstring, and a t-shirt that can be removed promptly following the plunge. **REMEMBER: Costume is considered on the judge's sheet!!!**

It's always fun to venture outside of the everyday norm, to try something new. Participants are encouraged to dress-up in a "theme" like lady/men of the evening, King or Queen, football or cheerleader or even Santa etc. Whichever you choose, please make sure any/all private parts are covered! Winter time and cold temperatures can bring just the thrill you're looking for, especially if you live near water. Participating in a polar plunge can be just the adventure you're after. Donning the proper attire can make your experience a lot less traumatic and maybe even enjoyable.

Bring at least two towels. One to wrap in and the other to stand on! Bring a buddy to help you with all of your stuff and one that you can count on to be there when you get out!!! Yikes!!

Protect the Tootsies

Shoes may not be at the top of your list when deciding on what to wear for the plunge, but they should be. The rocks and the water may have hazards you'll want to protect your feet. Water shoes with rubber soles or neoprene surf boots are both appropriate choices.

Post-plunge Attire

Choosing what to wear after the plunge is just as important as what to wear during the plunge. After you emerge from the frigid water, your only concern is going to be to get warm. Base layers for your top and bottom along with a cozy sweatshirt, pants, coat and hat will help get your body temperature back up where it should be. Don't forget warm socks and a pair of shoes, like boots or other slip-ons, that are easy to get on and don't require the use of your frozen fingers to tie laces.

Considerations

While you don't have to be a physically fit athlete to compete in a polar plunge, it's always a good idea to chat with your doctor about the event to make sure you're healthy enough for that kind of shock to the system. The Polar Bear Plungers, **DO NOT** dive into the water to avoid injuring yourself! Duh!!! If we have not had enough rain to make a deep plunging hole, diving would be a **VERY** bad idea!!!
